Tournament Check List

Initial Booking Requirements

- Contract signed and returned
- Deposit paid in full, non-refundable
- Credit card authorization form filled out

Once these steps are complete, your tournament is formally book and date will be secure

Two months prior

- Menu for banquet decided
- Sponsorship needs and provisions
- Floor plan for banquet finalized

One month prior

- Format of play selected
- On course activities in place
- Number of players confirmed
- Number of power carts required

Two weeks prior

- Number of dinner guests confirmed
- Final number of players confirmed
- All sponsors confirmed
- Finalize rental equipment required
- 100% Pre-Payment due; any additions will be invoiced and is to be paid within 10 days of event

One week prior

- Hole events/sponsors confirmed and submitted
- Players alpha list
- Player's groupings list
- Final checklist of golf course hole by hole requirements

One day prior

- Any last-minute additions confirmed with Tournament Coordinator
- All on course signage dropped off by 5pm
- Any donations for event dropped off by 5pm

Golf Etiquette and Tournament Guidelines

Shotgun Tournaments

Shotgun start tournaments require a full golf course buyout starting at 1pm. (Unless approved by the Tournament Supervisor, additional fees will apply). Mandatory meal requirement for all Shotgun Tournaments.

Tee Time Tournaments

The guaranteed number of guests for a tee time tournament is required 14 days prior to the event date.

Golf Cart Rentals

Meadow Gardens can accommodate golf cart rentals. Additional carts may be available from a third-party supplier with notice and based on availability. A reduction in cart rental reservations within 30 days may be subject to cancellation fees.

Code of Conduct

The Tournament Organizer is responsible for their guests' conduct and actions, and liable for any damage to Meadow Gardens property including the course, golf carts and clubhouse, caused by their participants. Meadow Gardens reserves the right to discontinue services to all guests in case of violation of club policy or provincial law.

Insurance

All Tournaments must have Commercial General Liability Insurance. All Tournaments must provide the Insurance Documents 14 days prior to Tournament Date.

Dress Code

Proper golf attire must be worn, shirts must have collars and sleeves, walking length shorts or slacks must be worn. Sweatpants, track pants and jeans/denim will not be permitted on the golf course or driving range. Meadow Gardens is a soft spike only facility.

Pace of Play

4.5 hours is the maximum acceptable pace of play. Strictly Enforced. Advice given by course marshals and staff regarding slow play must be adhered to. A surcharge of \$250 per 15 minutes may be issued for groups over the maximum allowable playing time. For shotgun starts, be prepared to add up to 60 minutes to the regular pace-of-play. We recommend discussing ways of improving pace-of-play with our Tournament Supervisor.

Course Set Up

Placement of signs, banners, etc. must be approved by Meadow Gardens. Meadow Gardens Golf Course will assume no responsibility for signs and banners left on the premises after the event. Meadow Gardens will assist with day of on course set up and take down (i.e., tables and chairs and signage.) All signage, tables, chairs, and other belongings to you must be taken from Meadow Gardens following the completion of your event. For shotgun tournaments Meadow Gardens will provide one table and two chairs per hole. Power carts are to be used for the purpose of transporting a maximum of two people at any one time. Meadow Gardens Golf Course assumes no responsibility for any loss and/or damage to goods, property and/or equipment brought into the facility by host or guests.

On Course Food and Beverage

All companies wishing to do any sort of tasting on the course must adhere to BC Liquor Laws.

In accordance with the BC Liquor Control and Licensing Act, Meadow Gardens will permit liquor sampling stations as follows:

All liquor for the sampling stations must be purchased through Meadow Gardens liquor license.

A maximum of two liquor sampling stations per nine holes will be permitted during an event. (A maximum of four liquor sampling stations permitted).

Samples are not to exceed one quarter of a standard portion size.

Any individual pouring or providing guests with liquor possesses a valid "Serving it Right" certificate.

All Serving it Right certificates must be photocopied and given to Meadow Gardens Prior to the event.

Meadow Gardens reserves the right to stop service for one or all sampling stations should there be a breach of any of these policies.

Food sampling will be permitted on course with the approval of the Tournament Supervisor.

Placement of sampling stations must be provided in writing two weeks prior to be approved by the Tournament Supervisor.

All questions regarding the laws can be directed to the Tournament Supervisor.

Banquet Facility Food and Beverage

In compliance with health regulations no outside food, beverages or storage coolers will be permitted to be brought in or taken out of the premises. Due to health regulations no leftover food or beverage may leave the property after an event.

We require the final number of banquet guests 14 days prior to your event. You will be charged with the guaranteed guest count, or the actual number of guests served, whichever is greater.

You will be required to confirm menu selections one month prior to your event with the Tournament Supervisor.

If any of the guests in your group have food allergies you must inform us of the guest's names and allergies, so we can take the necessary precautions when preparing their food.

No alcoholic beverages not purchased from Meadow Gardens are permitted to be consumed on premise, this includes in vehicles.

Meadow Gardens reserves the right to refuse service to any persons who appear under the age of 19 or who appear intoxicated in the opinion of Meadow Gardens staff.

Any participants found with alcohol, not purchased from Meadow Gardens will be asked to leave the premises without refund. Golf Bags may be inspected. STRICTLY ENFORCED.
